## Release of the Commercial Entities (Substance Requirements) Act, 2023 Guidelines

8<sup>th</sup> September, 2023

Further to the Ministry of Finance's Public Notice dated 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2023, the Commercial Entities (Substance Requirements) Act, 2023 ("CESRA 2023") has come into force with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2023. The new economic substance reporting portal has gone live on Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 for registered agent reporting.

Pursuant to Section 30 of CESRA 2023, the Ministry of Finance, as Authority, has compiled Guidelines which will provide further clarifications to entities on the new Economic Substance Regime in The Bahamas.
